BVAC Historic Motoring Extravaganza
to be held at Thirlestane Castle in the beautiful
Scottish Borders on
Sunday 4th of June 2017*

The show takes place on Sunday 4th of June 2017, with an entrant's scenic run on Saturday the 3rd. Magnificent, historic Thirlestane Castle is situated at Lauder, just 28 miles South of Edinburgh and 68 miles North of Newcastle on the A68 trunk road.

In this, our 45th year, with a "History of the British Sports Car" theme we hope to see many many examples of motoring from 'across-the-years' and indeed the world, as we can, as well as within our relatively new "Classic Youth" and "Kit" Classes.

Whilst **entry is free for exhibitors (INDIVIDUAL and CLUB)**, visiting members of the public are charged and mainly come to see *your* vehicle(s) on display. **By entering the show you agree that your vehicle remains on display to the paying public until the end of the show.**

Entries are accepted on the understanding that all vehicles have third party & public liability insurance and comply with current Road Traffic Regulations. The Club reserves the right to deny entry to any vehicle, which in its opinion is presented in an unacceptable condition, also judges may require evidence of vehicle function. The **closing date** for all entries will be **16th. April 2017**. No late entries can be guaranteed. All reasonable effort should be made to contact the organizers if, having made an entry, you are unable to attend.

SATURDAY 3rd JUNE - Setting-up day and optional ENTRANT'S SCENIC RUN (showground not open to the public). Our Scenic Run offers entrants a chance to enjoy outstanding views of the beautiful Scottish Borders. The Run starts from Thirlestane at 11 am, taking a circular route of approximately 90 to 100 miles with a stop for lunch. The run takes place under MSA regulations.

SUNDAY 4th JUNE - HISTORIC MOTORING EXTRAVAGANZA - GRAND PUBLIC DAY and CONCOURS. Entrants arriving on Sunday morning can access the showground from 8.30 am and are required to be in position no later than 10.30 please - the show opens to the public at 11.00. Concours judging will also start at 11.00. and concours entrants are requested to stay close to their vehicles until their class has been judged.

A trailer park is available to entrants bringing vehicles by trailer. Trailers unloading must be removed to the trailer park no later than 10.45am and may not re-enter for loading until the end of the show at 5pm.

The show will be open to the public from 11am to 5pm and in accordance with the approved Health and Safety Plan no vehicle movements may take place between these times without the specific authorization of the Chief Marshal.


